—The Boat—

- Designed and built in Australia.
- Rigged and launched in twenty minutes.
- Tough, top quality GRP semi-displacement hull.
- Self-draining and self-righting.
- Completely non-polluting electric retractable sail drive or inboard – instant power.
- Smart battery chargers – plug in and forget.
- Cruising range 12 hours or 5 hours at 5 knots.
- Navigation and bunk lights.
- Anchor well.
- Portable toilet and optional sink.
- Dorade type cabin ventilation.
- Canvas cuddy doubles as a cover when on the road.
- Full foam flotation.
- Ultra low maintenance.
- Solid timber trim, teak options.
- Ballasted fixed keel with water ballast option.
- Channels for safer staying, extra strength and easier access to the foredeck.



—The Crew—

- Seating for eight but six is comfortable.
- Two fixed berths in the cabin plus two or three under a boom tent.
- Zip-up canvas cuddy for shelter and privacy.

- No centreboard, no winches – simple and safe operation.
- Single-handed rigging and launching.

- Roll-up cockpit awning quickly rigged.
